BORDEN COUNTY TRANSFER STATION AND DUMPSTER GUIDELINES

The Borden County Transfer Station is located at 851 Willow Valley Road, Gail, Texas.

The transfer station is open on Wednesday afternoon from 3:00 to 6:00 pm and Saturday morning from 8:00 to 12:00 noon. An employee of Borden County will be on duty during these hours.

This employee will be documenting each vehicle as it enters.

This transfer station and dumpsters are for Borden County residents only.

The following guidelines pertain to the roll-offs and the dumpsters.

Items that are acceptable:

Herbicide containers will be accepted only if they have been rinsed three (3) times and the bottom of the container has been punctured and the lid removed.

Household waste, any waste or trash that is generated in a home or office.

Burn barrels that have been used to burn household waste will be accepted. <u>These barrels should not be emptied into the containers if they are smoldering.</u>

Construction waste such as small, short pieces of wood, dry wall, wallpaper, insulation, or glass.

Paint cans and buckets must be empty. The remaining residue must be completely dry.

Items that are not acceptable:

Rocks, gravel, and concrete materials.

Roofing shingles or any material containing asphalt.

Any items containing asbestos. This is strictly prohibited.

Oilfield or industrial waste. This is strictly prohibited.

Tires, batteries, free liquids or materials classified as hazardous or special waste. This is strictly prohibited.

Items that may be placed in metal pile:

Household appliances, lawn equipment, BBQ pits, air conditioners and other large devices.

Items that may be placed in the burn pile:

Tree limbs, garden and grass cuttings may be stacked in a designated area on the backside of the transfer containers. Large pieces of lumbar, pallets and furniture items.
