Commissioner Cargile informed that during the freeze she had inquired on a Generac and for a single home the price with installation was over \$15K, the benefits of this installation and the price should not be passed.

<u>MOTION:</u> Commissioner Gonzalez moved to purchase the Generac generators as listed in the proposal submitted by the NVFD, second by President M. Rodriguez. Being no discussion, motion passed unanimously.
