"I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.10 per \$100 valuation, consisting of a separately approved Debt Rate of \$0.0132 per \$100 valuation and a separately approved Maintenance and Operations Rate of \$0.0868 per \$100 valuation, which is effectively a 37.36 percent increase in the tax rate and will raise taxes for maintenance and operations on a \$100,00.00 home by \$27.20."

Second by Commissioner L. Rodriguez, Discussion: that Commissioner be allowed to submit the Resolution to the legally required entities and place on the website, being no further discussion, motion passed 5/0.
