# Regular Meeting Minutes September 18, 2025

# 1. CALL TO ORDER AND ESTABLISH QUORUM:

President Leo Rodriguez called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. A quorum was present with Commissioners Maria Sanchez, Reyna Vasquez, Leonel Garcia and Manuel Rodriguez.

## 2. BOARD MEMBER STATUS-COMMISSIONER COURT:

Administrator informed President Rodriguez and Treasurer Garcia that this may not be required since the first of September fell on a holiday, will inform further in October.

## 3. CITIZEN REGONITION AND COMMENTS:

### 4. SERVICE PROVIDERS REPORTS:

- A. LVFD-Chief Roger Garcia was present for questions.
  - a. Reports and receipts were emailed to BOESC.
  - b. <u>Inform-Chief Garcia informed the BOESC</u> that the SCBA invoice should be delivered at the October 16<sup>th</sup> meeting. (see minutes from August 21, 2025). Chief Garcia further informed the Board that the expired equipment is out of active service and used only for training purposes.

- B. NVFD-Grant writer Albert Saldana was present for questions.
  - a. Reports and receipts were emailed to BOESC.
  - b. <u>Inform-TX</u> legislature has approved fire-funding that should be available in several months. These grants are for specified items, and Member Saldana will be submitting grants for all areas where the NVFD would likely qualify. Member Saldana also thanked the Commissioner's for continuing to provide the funding for both Natalia and Lytle VFD's, this has resulted in MCESD #5 having the best ISO rating in Medina County, proper training, NFPA physicals, and the ability to have safe PPE. Commissioner Garcia inquired if Volunteers have had "water rescue training" and as to how the grants would be received, NVFD Member Saldana, explained it is on a reimbursement basis, and both Departments have sent Members to the "swift water rescue" training. LVFD Chief Garcia informed that the Members have opportunities for training locally at the facility located on Kinney Road, also at A & M Brayton fire training field in College Station through TEEX, and through SFFMA.

<u>Request- NVFD</u> is currently receiving bids for spray foam in the fire bay and will submit bids and requests in October.

### 5. PRESIDENT's REPORT:

- A. Bank information-Administrator EKC will discuss securities contracts with both banks for insurance of amounts exceeding the FDIC \$250K.
- B. ESD 2026-2028 appointments-EKC informed that Commissioner's L. Rodriguez, R. Vasquez, and L. Garcia are up for re-appointment. All 3 Commissioners have agreed to continue to serve. Admin provided all 3 with applications.
- C. Sales and Use tax revenue account-Admin EKC will get comparative interest rates from local banks for interest earning money markets and CD's.
