

BORDEN COUNTY

TRANSFER STATION GUIDELINES

The Borden County Transfer Station is located at 851 Willow Valley Road, Gail, Texas.

The transfer station is open on Wednesday afternoon from 3:00 to 6:00 pm and Saturday morning from 8:00 to 12:00 noon. An employee of Borden County will be on duty during these hours.

This employee will be available to assist you with your load.

This transfer station is for Borden County residents only.

Herbicide containers will be accepted only if they have been rinsed three (3) times and the bottom of the container has been punctured and the lid removed.

Household waste, any waste or trash that is generated in a home or office will be accepted.

Burn barrels that have been used to burn household waste will be accepted. These barrels should not be emptied into the containers if they are smoldering.

Household appliances will not be accepted.

Tree limbs, garden and grass cuttings may be stacked in a designated area on the backside of the transfer containers. Please do not put these items in the containers.

Steel, iron or any sheet metal material will not be allowed.

Construction waste such as small, short pieces of wood, dry wall, wallpaper or glass will be accepted.

Rocks and concrete materials will not be accepted.

Paint cans and buckets must be empty. The remaining residue must be completely dry. This does not include paint thinners, or like chemicals.

Any items containing asbestos will not be allowed in the containers.

Roofing shingles or any material containing asphalt will not be allowed in the containers.

Oilfield or industrial waste cannot be accepted. This is strictly prohibited.

Tires, batteries, free liquids or materials classified as hazardous or special waste cannot be placed in the containers at any time.

The guidelines are required by Borden County and Republic Disposal.
