Section 152.013 PROCEDURE FOR SETTING AMOUNTS FOR ELECTED OFFICERS

- a) Each year the Commissioners Court shall set the salary, expenses, and other allowances of elected county or precinct officers. The Commissioners Court shall set the items at a regular meeting of the Court during the regular budget hearing and adoption proceedings.
- b) Before the 10th day before the date of the meeting, the Commissioners Court must publish in a newspaper of general circulation a notice of:
 - 1) Any salaries, expenses, or allowances that are proposed to be increased;
 - 2) The amount of the proposed increase.
