ORDER CLOSING ALLEY

ON the 28th day of April 2026, after due notice as required by law, the Commissioners Court of Borden County, Texas, meeting in special session, took up for consideration and action the following matter: Closing 3 alleys between West Dow Avenue and West Joplin Avenue beginning at Maple and ending at Unidentified Street as submitted by Borden County ISD

WHEREFORE, State law provides, in §251.051 of the Texas Transportation Code that the County Commissioners Court has authority to close an existing road;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Borden County, Texas, pursuant to that authority and with a unanimous vote, has determined the alleys between Block 83 and Block 82, the alley between Block 82 and 81 and the alley west of Block 81, located between W. Dow Avenue and W Joplin Avenue in the Township of Gail should be closed;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the 3 alleys between W Dow Avenue and W Joplin Avenue in Block 83, 82 and 81 in Precinct #1 in the Township of Gail is CLOSED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, Borden County conveys all 20' of the former allies that runs in Block 83,82 and ½ of 81 in the Township of Gail to Borden County ISD and ½ of alley west of Block 81 to the Ralph Miller family.

WHEREFORE, State law provides, in §251.051 of the Texas Transportation Code that the County Commissioners Court has authority to close an existing road;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Borden County, Texas, pursuant to that authority and with a unanimous vote, has determined the that West Dow Avenue beginning at Maple and ending at Unidentified Street in the Township of Gail should be closed;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the W Dow Avenue between Block 81 and 67 and ending at entrance to Unidentified Street between Block 70 and 83 in Precinct #1 in the Township of Gail is CLOSED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, Borden County conveys all 600' of former Dow Avenue between Maple and Unidentified Street in the Township of Gail to Borden County ISD.
