



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Reporting Requirement(s) Not Met for

Borden County Water System PWS 0170010

We are required to report the results of monitoring of your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis by MAY 2020. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During MAY 2020, we did not report the results of monitoring for total coliform.

Our system failed to notify the state drinking water program as required by MAY 2020. Although public health was not impacted, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other actions.

What is being done? (Corrective action): In order to return to compliance, we had to collect a routine distribution sample and that sample was collected on 06/24/2020 and we were no longer in violation.
