Commissioner Dillard made a motion to approve the minutes from February 24, 2026, as presented, duly seconded by Commissioner Bradshaw. Motion carried 3-0.

RECEIVE COUNTY TREASURER'S REPORT – TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION

Mrs. Gierisch presented the Year-to-Date Summary General Ledger Trial Balance report from October 1, 2025, to February 28, 2026, with a balance of \$9,191,705.76. She also presented the Summary Statement of Operations – Expenditures report, with an ending balance of \$7,732,537.63. The Summary Statement of Operations – Revenues report with 97.09% realized. Commissioner Bradshaw made a motion to approve the County Treasurer's Report, as presented, duly seconded by Commissioner Dillard. Motion carried 3-0. See Exhibits "E", "F", and "G", respectively.

CONSIDER/APPROVE ALL ACCOUNTS PAYABLE FOR CONCHO COUNTY – TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION

Mrs. Hamill presented the monthly Accounts Payable Claim Register from February 24, 2026, through March 10, 2026, with a total of \$284,386.99; as well as the Gross Pay for February. Commissioner Bradshaw made a motion to approve and pay all accounts due and owed by Concho County, duly seconded by Commissioner Dillard. Motion carried 3-0. See Exhibit "H"




