CONSIDER/DISCUSS/APPROVE CANVASS OF THE MARCH 3, 2026, REPUBLICAN AND DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY ELECTIONS – TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION

Ms. Infante presented to Commissioners Court the finalized counts from the March 3, 2026, Republican and Democratic Primary Elections. Commissioner Miller made a motion to accept and approve the canvassing of the March 3, 2026, Republican and Democratic Primary Election, as presented, duly seconded by Commissioner Dillard. Motion carried unanimously.

CONSIDER/DISCUSS/APPROVE ADOPTING CHAPTER 826 ON RABIES FROM THE TEXAS HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE AND DESIGNATING OFFICERS TO ACT AS THE LOCAL RABIES CONTROL AUTHORITY FOR CONCHO COUNTY, TEXAS – TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION

Commissioner Bradshaw made a motion to accept adopting Chapter 826 on Rabies from the Texas Health and Safety Code and designation the County Sheriff to act as the Local Rabies Control Authority for Concho County, Texas, duly seconded by Commissioner Miller. Motion carried unanimously. See Exhibit "B"

The Court recessed from Open Court at 10:19 a.m. and was reconvened in Executive Session, pursuant to Texas Government Code 551.0725.

The Court reconvened back into Open Court at 11:10 am from Executive Session, with no action being taken.

Commissioners Court proceeded to the old Precinct 1 barn with Gallagher Construction examine the condition of the old barn. No action taken.




